**Location:** Icelandic Exclusive Economic Zone (200nm) within ICES V / FAO area 27

**Fishing methods:** Demersal otter trawl, Danish seine, long line, hand line and gill net.

**Number of fisheries:** 1

## The fishery: Unit of certification

The certified **ISF Icelandic haddock** fishery is defined as:

<b>Species</b>	Atlantic Haddock ( <i>melanogrammus aeglefinus</i> )
<b>Geographical range of fishing operations</b>	Exclusive economic zone (200 miles) of Iceland
<b>Method of capture</b>	Demersal otter trawl, Danish seine, long line, hand line and gill net
<b>Stock</b>	Icelandic haddock stock (ICES Division Va) / FAO 27
<b>Management</b>	Coastal state (Iceland) management regime. Ministry of Fisheries & Agriculture, Iceland; Directorate of Fisheries; Icelandic Coastguard Service.
<b>Client group</b>	The client group consists of the entire Icelandic fleet landing their catch for Icelandic Group PLC and authenticated certificate sharers.
